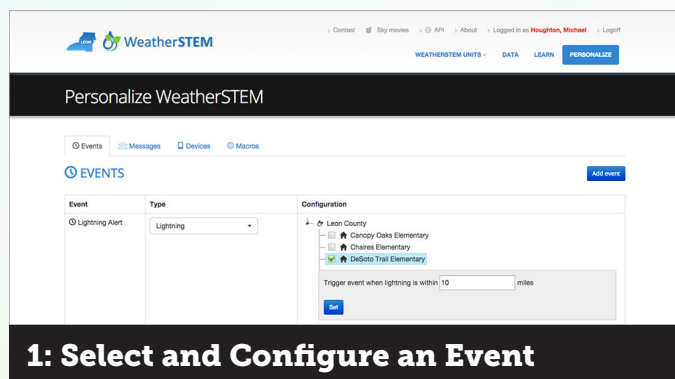

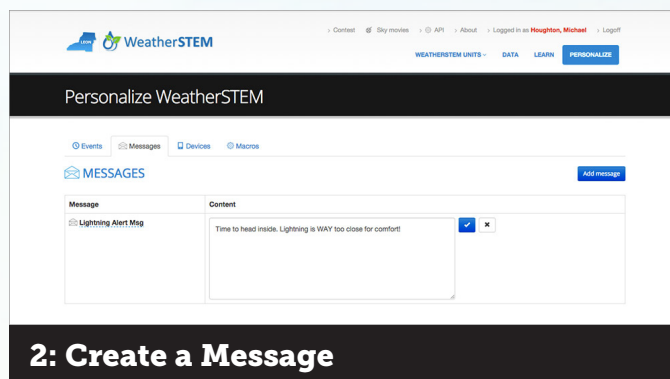
# Creating a Notification

After logging in to your WeatherSTEM account, you have the ability to create a variety of notifications under the “Personalize” link. Notifications are customizable, recipe-like combinations of four ingredients: 1) an *Event* which triggers, 2) a *Message* that is sent to, 3) a *Device*, all of which are connected with, 4) a *Macro*. The following example provides an overview of the process.\*



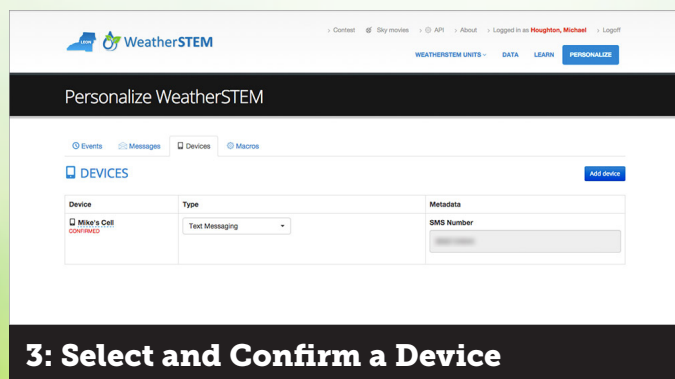
### 1: Select and Configure an Event

Under the **Events** tab, click “Add event.” Name your new event, select the *Type* of event, and customize the event *Configuration*.



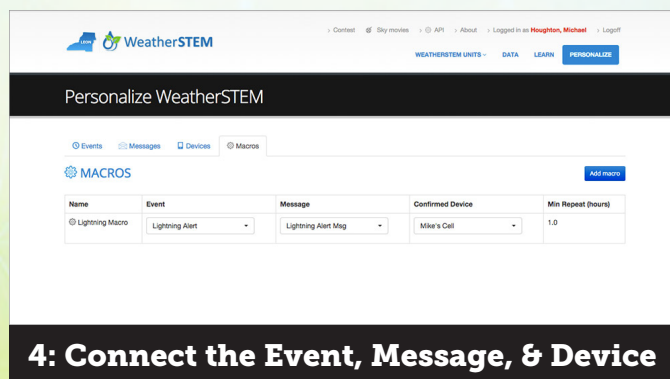
### 2: Create a Message

Under the **Messages** tab, click “Add message.” Name your new message, and write your custom message *Content*.



### 3: Select and Confirm a Device

Under the **Devices** tab, click “Add device.” Name your new device, select the *Type* of device, and add the *Metadata*.



### 4: Connect the Event, Message, & Device

Under the **Macros** tab, click “Add macro.” Name your new macro, select the *Event*, *Message*, & *Device*, and add *Min Repeat*.
